BREATHLESS REPORTING ONCE AGAIN!

The reporting by FingerLakes1.com of the meeting held last night by certain individuals who oppose our federally authorized leadership—"*Cayuga Nation unrest continues after meeting in Seneca Falls*"—is largely both an imaginative and unnecessarily energized account of what actually occurred.

Let's be clear—at no time did the Nation's federally-authorized Police Force enter upon the premises where the meeting being held, attempt to disrupt the meeting in any way, or "speed off", provoking anyone into giving chase. More important, no effort was made last night by our Police Force or anyone authorized by our leadership to regain possession of the residential premises owned by the Cayuga Nation on Rt. 124 in the Town of Varick. Suggesting otherwise is simply irresponsible and only heightens the air of tension—as well as promotes the false narrative—created by our opposition.

The residential premises in the Town of Varick are one of many occupied by dissident citizens of our Nation who have not paid *one dime* of rent to the Nation *for years*. If and when a decision is made to reclaim these additional stolen properties, it will be done lawfully using our Nation's judicial system, with full due process afforded to all.
